

Driving Gloves

Yarn: Patons 4ply 100%

Cotton 2 balls Blk(1712)

Crn(1692)

Hook: 3.5mm

Tension: 16rows by 20sts worked in htr.

Measurement: 18cms around knuckles

Stitches:

Dc = Double Crochet

Htr = Half Treble

Ch = Chain

Ss = Slip Stitch.

Notions:

4x pearl buttons.

10cm leatherette.

Tapestry needle.

Stitch Markers

Abbreviations:

WS = Wrong side

RS = Right side

FO = Fasten Off

St = Stitch

GLOVE (Make 2) – Using Cream yarn work 33ch.

R1 – 1dc into 2nd ch from hook, 1dc to the end, turn.

R2 to R6 – 2ch (doesn't count as a st), 1htr to the end, turn.

LEFT HAND

R7 – 2ch, (doesn't count as a st), 1htr into next 6sts, 2htr into next st, 1htr to last 11sts, 2htr into next st, 1htr to end, turn.

R8 – 2ch, (doesn't count as a st), 1htr into next 10sts, 2htr into next st, 1htr to last 8sts, 2htr into next st, 1htr to end, turn.

R9 – 2ch, (doesn't count as a st), 1htr to last 12sts, 2htr into next st, 1htr to end, turn.

R10 – 2ch, (doesn't count as a st), 1htr into next 11sts, 2htr into next st, 1htr to end, turn.

R11 – 2ch, (doesn't count as a st), 1htr into each st to last 13 sts, 2htr into next st, 1htr to end, turn.

R12 – 2ch, (doesn't count as a st), 1htr to end, turn.

R13 – 2ch, (doesn't count as a st), 1htr to end, 5ch, ss to join into top of beg 2ch on opposite side, FO. Sew in yarn ends. (DO NOT TURN AT END OF ROW). Lay flat with opening facing upwards.

R14 – Count 17sts round from right side of opening, join in yarn on WS, 2ch, (counts as 1htr), 1htr into each st to 5ch, 1htr into each ch, 1htr to end, ss to join, turn.

R15, R16 and R17 – RS, WS and RS, 2ch, (counts as 1htr), 1htr into each st to end, ss to join, turn.

R18 – WS, 2ch, (counts as 1htr), 1htr into each st to last 8sts, 6ch, sk5, 1htr to end, ss to join, turn.

R19 – RS, 2ch, (counts as 1htr), 1htr into each st to 6ch, 1htr into each ch, 1htr to end, ss to join, turn.

RIGHT HAND

R7 – 2ch, (doesn't count as a st), 1htr into next 9sts, 2htr into next st, 1htr to last 10sts, 2htr into next st, 1htr to end, turn.

R8 - 2ch, (doesn't count as a st), 1htr into next 9sts, 2htr into next st, 1htr to last 11sts, 2htr into next st, 1htr to end, turn.

R9 – 2ch, (doesn't count as a st), 1htr into next 10sts, 2htr into next st, 1htr to end, turn.

R10 – 2ch, (doesn't count as a st), 1htr to last 12sts, 2htr into next st, 1htr to end, turn.

R11 – 2ch, (doesn't count as a st), 1htr into next 11sts, 2htr into next st, 1htr to end, turn.

R12 – repeat instructions for Left Hand.

R13 – 2ch, (doesn't count as a st), 1htr to end, 5ch, ss to join into top of beg 2ch on opposite side, FO. Sew in yarn ends. (DO NOT TURN AT END OF ROW). Lay flat with opening facing upwards.

R14 – Count 17sts round from left side of opening, join in yarn on WS, 2ch, (counts as 1htr), 1htr into each st to 5ch, 1htr into each ch, 1htr to end, ss to join, turn.

R15 to R17 – repeat instructions for Left Hand.

R18 – WS, 2ch, (counts as 1htr), 1htr into next 11sts, 6ch, sk5, 1htr to end, ss to join, turn.

R19 – RS, 2ch, (counts as 1htr), 1htr into each st to 6ch, 1htr into each ch, 1htr to end, ss to join, turn.

LEFT & RIGHT HAND

R20, R22 and R24 – WS, 2ch, (counts as 1htr), 1htr into each st to end, ss to join, turn. FO on last round.

R21 and R23 – RS, Repeat R20.

MAKING THE FINGERS (Work these rounds before R25)

Put gloves on each hand and use a stitch marker to mark gap between little finger and ring finger.

LITTLE FINGER LEFT HAND

R1 – RS, join yarn into palm side of glove at marker, 3ch across and join at other marker point to form hole for finger, work 2ch, 1htr into each st round, work into each 3ch, ss to join, turn.

R2 and R3 – WS and RS, 2ch, (counts as 1htr), 1htr into each st to end, FO.

LITTLE FINGER RIGHT HAND

R1, R2 and R3 – Repeat instructions as for Left Hand but join yarn into outer side of glove.

WORKING BACK INTO MAIN GLOVE

R25 – RS, join yarn into palm side, 2ch (counts as a stitch) work 1htr round, when you reach little finger, work 1htr into bottom loop of 3ch so that fingers are joined, 1htr to end, ss to join, FO.

[Put gloves on each hand and use a stitch marker to mark gap between ring and index finger, then index and forefinger].

WORKING REMAINING FINGERS

LEFT HAND, (work ring and index finger)

R1 – RS, join yarn into palm side of glove at marker, 3ch across and join at other marker point to form hole for finger, work 2ch, 1htr into each st round, work 1htr into bottom loop of each 3ch to join fingers together, ss to join, turn.

R2 and R3 – Repeat instructions for Little Finger.

FOREFINGER

R1 – RS, join yarn into palm side, 2ch (counts as a 1htr), work 1htr round to end, work 1htr into bottom loop of each 3ch to join fingers together, ss to join, turn.

R2 and R3 – Repeat instructions for Little Finger.

RIGHT HAND

Repeat instructions for Left Hand, but join yarn into outer side of glove.

THUMB

R1 – RS, join yarn into top of any st in thumb space, 2ch, (counts as 1htr), work 1htr round, working 1htr into side of st and into bottom of 6ch loops, to end, ss to join, turn.

R2 and R3 – Repeat instructions for Little Finger.

Sew in yarn ends, gently steam press.

ACCENT COLOUR

Using Black Yarn work accent around top of each finger and wrist. (Repeat for both gloves)

FINGERS & THUMB

Work, 1ch (doesn't count as a st), 1dc to end, ss to join, FO. Repeat round the top of each finger and thumb, sew in yarn ends.

WRIST

Join yarn into bottom loop of foundation ch, 1ch, (doesn't count as a st), 1dc into each loop working from left hand side of outer part of glove, around wrist, when you get to right side of opening, work 2dc into corner, work 48 dc into opening, 2dc into next corner, ss into beginning 1dc to join, FO.

FASTENING LOOPS

RIGHT HAND - Count up 12dc from the bottom, *join in yarn, 5ch, sk st, ss to join into next 1dc, FO, count 6dc down, repeat 1 more time from * to FO.

LEFT HAND - join yarn in to 1st dc on left side, * 5ch, sk st, ss into next 1dc, FO, count 6dc up, join in yarn, repeat 1 more time from * to FO.

MAKING UP Sew in all ends, steam/block lightly. Attach buttons. Scan and increase patch image for correct size, pierce round edge with tapestry needle with a gap of about 0.5cms. Place on glove and using cream yarn, work a running stitch or over stitch to attach to glove. (Use image of gloves as a guide).
